

About North-Eastern Handicrafts and Handloom Development Corporation (NEHHDC):

North Eastern Handicrafts and Handlooms Development Corporation (NEHHDC), incorporated in 1977, is an organization that attempts to develop and promote the indigenous crafts of the region by connecting craftsmen to prospective markets and consumers and generating economic, cultural, and social opportunities for creators while adding cultural value for consumers. The corporation is under the administrative control of the Ministry of Development of North Eastern Region (MDoNER), Government of India.

Eri Silk Spinning Plant (NEHHDC):

The Eri Silk Spinning Mill, under the North Eastern Handicrafts and Handlooms Development Corporation, was established in 2025 at the Integrated Textile Park, Baksa, to enhance Eri silk production using advanced, state-of-the-art techniques. Specializing in high-quality spinning and dyeing, the plant ensures efficiency, precision and sustainability. The plant cost approximately Rs. 14.92 crore to set up and has a production capacity of about 200 kgs of Eri silk yarn per day. Its purpose is to boost the production and promotion of Eri silk, create employment, and provide a livelihood for local communities.


1. Background of the EOI:

North Eastern Handicrafts and Handlooms Development Corporation (NEHHDC) have set up an Eri Silk Plant at Mushalpur, Baksa (BTC) in an area of around five (05) bighas at ITPO complex, Baksa. The plant is a small-scale facility with manufacturing units in three complex, one measuring approximately 12500 sq ft and the other two complexes of approximately 3300 sq ft comprising machines for making Eri yarn/thread. Both the complex has roof top facility with adequate open outdoor ground space.

2. Objective of the Assignment:

The main objective for empanelment of firms/organizations in this regard is:

- i. Ensure Reliable and Quality Raw Material Supply:**
To establish a dependable pool of verified cocoon suppliers capable of providing **consistent, high-quality Eri cocoons** in accordance with the plant's production standards.
- ii. Strengthen Supply Chain Efficiency:**
To streamline procurement through a structured supplier base that enables **timely, cost-effective, and uninterrupted** availability of raw cocoons.
- iii. Promote Transparency and Fair Procurement Practices:**
To adopt a transparent and competitive empanelment process that ensures **fair**



pricing, accountability, and compliance with organizational procurement norms.

- iv. **Support Local Sericulture Farmers and Producer Groups:**
To encourage participation of **local growers, SHGs, FPOs, sericulture clusters and traditional rearers**, thereby promoting rural livelihood enhancement in the Baksa region.
- v. **Build Long-term Partnerships:**
To cultivate sustainable and mutually beneficial relationships with suppliers for **continuous improvement, capacity development, and supply stability**.
- vi. **Increase Production Capacity and Operational Efficiency:**
To ensure adequate raw material availability for scaling production and achieving the plant's **target output and operational efficiency goals**.
- vii. **Encourage Standardized Post-Harvest Practices:**
To bring in suppliers who follow recommended **hygiene, handling, storage, and transportation standards**, ensuring minimal damage or contamination.

3. Scope of Work

The empanelled cocoon suppliers shall be responsible for ensuring timely, consistent, and quality supply of Eri cocoons to the ERI Silk Plant, Baksa. The scope of work includes, but is not limited to, the following:

- i. **Supply of Quality Eri Cocoons with proper storage facility:**
Supply fresh, clean, well-graded Eri cocoons in accordance with the quality standards, specifications, and moisture norms prescribed by the plant. Ensure that all cocoons are free from defects, pest infestation, excessive moisture, contamination, or adulteration.
- ii. **Sustainable and Timely Delivery:**
Deliver cocoons on a regular, timely, and need-based schedule as communicated by the plant authorities. Maintain the capacity to supply required quantities during peak production periods.
- iii. **Procurement, Collection & Handling:**
Collect cocoons directly from farmers, rearers, SHGs, or production units while ensuring adherence to ethical procurement and fair-trade practices. Ensure proper handling, drying, sorting, and packaging to prevent damage or deterioration during transportation.
- iv. **Transportation & Logistics:**
Arrange transportation of cocoons to the ERI Silk Plant, Baksa, at the supplier's cost and responsibility, unless specified otherwise. Ensure safe, hygienic and secure transport with minimal spoilage or loss.



v. Documentation & Compliance:

Maintain detailed records of supply volumes, source, and quality grade for traceability. Comply with all regulations, guidelines, and quality protocols set by the ERI Silk Plant and relevant government authorities.

vi. Quality Assurance & Inspection:

Facilitate inspection, sampling, and testing of cocoons by the plant's quality inspection team at any stage—collection, arrival, or warehouse. Replace or take back any rejected or sub-standard consignments at no additional cost.

vii. Price Discipline:

Supply cocoons at rates mutually agreed upon or determined by the procurement mechanism adopted by the plant (e.g., fixed rate, daily rate, auction model, etc.). Ensure adherence to transparent pricing norms without overcharging or market distortion.

viii. Ethical and Sustainable Practices:

Promote and support sustainable sericulture practices among farmers and rearers. Avoid involvement in any activities that may compromise quality, fairness, or environmental sustainability. Child labour will not be entertained under any circumstances.

ix. Coordination & Communication:

Maintain effective coordination with the plant management for demand forecasts, schedules, Quality Inspection of Cocoons and logistic planning. Promptly communicate any supply constraints or production issues to avoid disruption.

x. Continuous Improvement:


Participate in training, capacity-building initiatives, or quality enhancement programs organized by the plant or government agencies. Adopt improved harvesting and post-harvest management techniques as recommended.

Note: The scope of work as mentioned above is indicative and should not be considered as limited as per the above points.



4. Terms and Conditions

- i. The EOI documents can be downloaded from the website of North Eastern Handicrafts and Handlooms Corporation Limited and the CPP portal.
- ii. Online tenders addressed to the **Managing Director (MD), North Eastern Handicrafts and Handlooms Corporation Limited, Guwahati, Assam** must be submitted through the CPP portal only **on or before 13:00 Hrs: 15/01/2026**.
- iii. The proposals shall be submitted in the following manner and shall contain details/ documents as listed below:
 - a) Forwarding letter on the letterhead of the firm/organization.
 - b) A complete set of the EOI documents along with all other supporting documents duly filled and signed by the authorized signatory of the firm/organization with the official seal of the organization/firm etc.
 - c) In case the proposals are being submitted by a partnership firm, it must be signed by each partner thereof or in the event of the absence of any partner, it must be signed on his behalf by a person holding a power of attorney authorizing him to do so.
 - d) An Index page showing contents/annexure & page no should be annexed first, followed by relevant documents with proper page numbering & signed by the owner of the firm or his Authorized Signatory as a token of acceptance of Terms & Conditions. In case the proposals are signed by any Authorized signatory, a copy of the power of attorney/ authorization letter (in the company's letterhead) is to be enclosed along with the Bid
 - e) It shall be ensured that every page of the bid document is duly numbered and signed with the seal of the bidder without any cutting and overwriting.
- iv. Falsification/suppression of information shall lead to disqualification of the bidder/cancellation of the contract, even after the award of work during the currency of the contract.
- v. Bidders shall not obtain or attempt to obtain any unfair advantage over other bidders in the preparation and submission of their proposals. Engaging in such practices may lead to disqualification of the bidder.
- vi. Tenders received after the prescribed time and date will not be considered.
- vii. Conditional tenders will not be accepted and will be summarily rejected.
- viii. The bidder must ensure that the conditions laid down for submission of offers are complete and correctly filled. Over writing of bids will be treated as cancelled.
- ix. Any changes/modifications with respect to this EOI will be duly notified on our official website.
- x. It shall be ensured that every page of the EOI document is duly numbered and signed with the seal of the bidder without any cutting and overwriting.
- xi. North Eastern Handicrafts and Handlooms Corporation Limited will have the option to terminate the contract if the bidder commits any of the conditions contained in this EOI.

- xii. The bidder shall ensure that none of his personnel on duty is inebriated state or consumes drugs, prohibited substances, etc, while on at the designated workplace.
- xiii. The track record of the bidder should be clean and should not have any involvement in illegal activities or financial fraud. There should not be any case with the Police/Court/Regulatory authorities against the bidder.
- xiv. The firm/organization should not assign or sublet the work or any part of it to any other vendor/firm in any form. Such actions shall result in the termination of empanelment
- xv. Any changes/modification with respect to this EOI will be duly notified in our official website (www.nehhdc.com) and CPP portal (www.etenders.gov.in).
- xvi. Bidder shall be liable for any supply of inferior quality of cocoons that is not satisfactory to NEHHDC and should make good all such damages.
- xvii. NEHHDC may reject part or whole batch of cocoon supply, if the cocoon as offered by the vendor does not meet the " Quality Assessment & Quality Check" criteria as set by NEHHDC while quality inspection of the cocoon before accepting the final delivery of cocoon.
- xviii. North Eastern Handicrafts and Handlooms Corporation Limited reserves the right to reject any or all of the tenders received without assigning any reason thereof.
- xix. **Any dispute arising out of the contract will be settled under the Guwahati Jurisdiction.**

5. Eligibility Criteria:

A. Legal Entity Status

- a) The applicant must be a **legally constituted organization**, such as:
 - i. SHG/Corporative Society
 - ii. FPO/FPC
 - iii. Proprietorship Firm
 - iv. Partnership Firm
 - v. Limited Company / Corporate Body
- b) The entity must possess valid registration documents with a minimum validity of **12 months** from the date of proposal submission.
 - i. Start-ups operational for less than 12 months are exempted but must submit proof of incorporation/registration under DPIIT.

B. Valid Trade License

- a) The bidder must hold a **current and valid Trade License** (or equivalent license relevant to the cocoon supply business).

C. Statutory Registrations

The bidder must possess:

- i. **GST Registration Certificate**
- ii. **PAN Card** (in the name of the firm/proprietor/partners)



- iii. **Registration Copy** of Firm, Company, Cooperative Society, etc.

D. Mandatory Organizational Documents

- a) The bidder must submit:

- i. Certificate of Incorporation / Registration
- ii. Memorandum & Articles of Association or Partnership Deed
- iii. Proprietorship declaration (if applicable)

E. Non-Blacklisting Status

- a) The bidder must submit a **Non-Blacklisting Declaration** (Annexure B) confirming that:

- i. They are **not blacklisted** by any Central/State Government, PSU, or regulatory authority.
- ii. They are **not involved in any fraud, criminal case, or disciplinary proceedings.**

F. Authorization Letter

- a) If the bid is signed by an authorized representative, an **Authorization Letter** (Annexure C) must be submitted on the organization's letterhead.

G. Clean Legal and Financial Record

- a) The bidder must have:

- i. **No pending or ongoing cases** with Police, Court, or regulatory bodies.
- ii. **No history of financial fraud** or malpractice.

H. Acceptance of EOI Terms

- a) Every page of the EOI document and the bid must be:

- i. **Signed and sealed** by the authorized signatory.
- ii. Free from overwriting, tampering, or omissions.

I. Capability to Supply Quality Eri Cocoons

The bidder must be capable of:

- a) Supplying **fresh, clean, well-graded Eri cocoons** as per NEHHDC technical specifications:
- i. **≤ 2000 cocoons per kg** for Grade A quality
 - ii. **≤ 2300 cocoons per kg** for Grade B quality
 - iii. Moisture content **≤ 8%**
 - iv. Free from defects, stains, mold, pests, or contamination
- b) Ensuring proper handling, drying, storage, grading, and transportation.

J. Submission of EOI Fee

- a) Submission of the **non-refundable EOI Document Fee of Rs. 5,000** (except MSMEs, which are exempted).

6. Technical Specification for Supply of Eri Cocoons:



Vendors submitting Expression of Interest (EOI) for the supply of Eri cocoons to **Eri Silk Spinning Plant, NEHHDC**, must comply with the following technical and quality specifications:

A. Cocoon Weight Analysis Requirements

- i. Vendors must provide batch-wise and Grade-wise cocoon weight data. In this regard, it is to keep in mind that, less than 2000 number of cocoons per kilogram will be considered as Grade A cocoon, however it must satisfy the other quality inspection parameters.
- ii. Cocoon weight analysis must be conducted using a calibrated digital weighing balance.

B. Physical Quality Parameters

Vendors must ensure that the supplied cocoons meet the following standards:

- i. **Cocoon Color:** Acceptable colors are **Cream to Light Brown** only; bleached or discolored cocoons will not be accepted.
- ii. **Surface Cleanliness:** Cocoons should be **clean and free from dust, stains, mold, insect droppings, fungal infection, unpleasant odour or any other external impurities** and properly sun dried.
- iii. **Shape Uniformity:** Cocoons must be of **good, uniform shape**, with minimum variation in size.
- iv. **Moisture Content:** Moisture should not exceed **8%**, and measurement must be taken using a calibrated moisture meter.
- v. Any cocoons showing signs of **mold, pest infestation, wetness, or structural deformities** will be rejected.

C. Quality Grading Criteria

Supplied cocoons will be graded at NEHHDC as per the following criteria:

1. Grade A -

- i. Less than 2000 number of cocoons per kilogram.
- ii. Excellent quality
- iii. Uniform, clean, and dry
- iv. No defects will be allowed after random physical inspection, like dirt, dust, stinky cocoons, cut cocoon, etc., beyond the defect acceptance limit of 1% of the number of cocoons per kg of the selected sample.
- v. If the selected sample of the cocoon offered under the Grade "A" category does not meet the requisite criteria (Grade A), it may be considered under the Grade "B" category, provided the requisite criteria as pre-defined under the Grade "B" category are duly met.

2. Grade B-

- vi. 2000 - 2300 number of cocoons per kilogram.
- vii. Good quality



- viii. Uniform, clean, and dry
- ix. No defects will be allowed after random physical inspection like dirt, dust, stained cocoons, cut cocoon etc. beyond the defect acceptance limit of 5% of the number of cocoons per kg of the selected sample.

For assessment of the "Quality Grading Criteria" a minimum of 20% of the total lot/batch received will be considered for "Random Sampling"

D. Documentation & Reporting Requirements

- i. Vendors must submit the **Cocoon Quality Report** in NEHHDC format along with each consignment.
- ii. The report must be signed by an authorized representative of the vendor.
- iii. Vendor must declare the source of cocoons (geographical region and rearing center).
- iv. Any adulteration or misrepresentation will lead to immediate blacklisting.

E. Lot Acceptance Criteria

- i. Acceptance is strictly based on NEHHDC inspection results for each lot.
- ii. Lots failing to meet specified quality parameters will be **rejected**.
- iii. Rejected lots must be lifted back by the vendor at their own cost within the specified timeline.

7. Payment Terms:

- i. Payment will be released in **two installments** after successful delivery and quality clearance by NEHHDC.
- ii. **50% payment** will be made within 10 (ten) days upon:
 - a. Delivery of cocoons
 - b. Completion of quality inspection
 - c. Acceptance of the lot as per NEHHDC quality parameters
- iii. The remaining **50% payment** will be released **after 30 days** from the date of initial payment.
- iv. Any rejected lot will not be eligible for payment and must be taken back by the vendor at their own cost.

8. Delivery Terms:

The Empanelled Vendor shall deliver the Eri Cocoons to the Buyer's premises at Eri Silk Spinning Mill, Integrated Textile Park, Kharuajan, Mushalpur, Bkasa, BTR, or as otherwise agreed. The risk of loss or damage during transit will be borne by the Seller until delivery is completed.

9. Force Majeure Clause :



In an event of Force Majeure resulting in a loss or damage to crop due to the act of God viz. failure of Monsoon, Pandemic, pest attack, drought or any such event, then the empanelled vendor shall not be held responsible for short supply or non-supply of the contracted quantity.

10. Requisite eligibility documents:

The Party should furnish the following documents along with the Proposal:

- i. Name and Postal address, the Firms/Agencies/Organizations
- ii. Forwarding Letter on the letter head of the Organization as per **Annexure A**.
- iii. It must be a legally constituted SHG/Cooperative Society/Proprietary firm/Partnership firm/ Limited Company/Corporate Body, who possess the required registrations etc., as per law with prior validity at least for 12 months from the date of the submission of proposal. Such start-ups which were operationalised less than 12 months prior to submission of proposal are exempted for the time period criteria, however they have to compulsorily submit all requisite documents from the date of their incorporation. In this regard, Certificate of Incorporation/Certificate of Registration or similar legal document must be submitted.
- iv. Article of memorandum of association or partnership deed or affidavit of the sole proprietorship deed as the case may be.
- v. Copy of valid up to date Trade License or equivalent specific to the job.
- vi. Copy of the GST registration certificate
- vii. Photocopy of I.T PAN card (In the name of firm/proprietor/partners etc)
- viii. Non-Black Listed certificate in the letter head of the organization as per Annexure B
- ix. Authorization letter to sign Bid Documents in the letter head of the Organization as per Annexure C
- x. Check List as per Annexure D

11. Selection Criteria

Based on the EOI proposal as received by North Eastern Handlooms & Handicrafts Corporation Limited (NEHHDC), it will select the most appropriate/eligible and deserving vendor in line with the requirement and suitability of NEHHDC. The selection criteria of the firm/organization will be done on the basis of successful fulfillment of the **eligibility criteria** and **submission of all requisite documents** as specified at **point no. "9" & point no. "10"** in this EOI and the selected firm/organization will be considered as Technically qualified only. However, this will not give any claim to the party for award of work/ purchase order.
